I am so excited to share Bhutan with you for many reasons and here are a few...

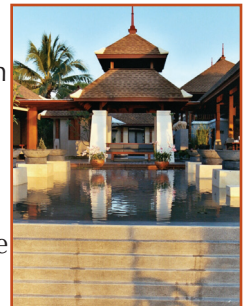
