--required attendance when applying to be an Intern unless arrangements are made in advance with Wings.

Feb 11th, 5:00 pm

- Intern applications due

Feb 22nd & 24th

- Intern interviews

Feb 25th

- Selection and notification

Apr 21st, 8:30-5:00 pm

- Training with Wings staff

Apr 22nd, 8:30-9:00 pm

- Training with Wings staff and outgoing Interns

Apr 28th

- New LifeWorks session begins

EDUCATIONAL CREDITS

The internship program offers 450 hours of training during the course of the year or 45 CEU's. College level credit for the internship is possible and it is each individual's responsibility to work with their educational institution to determine eligibility. We will assist you when possible.

ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible to apply for the Internship if you will have completed PES, CrossOver and LifeWorks by April 2011.

INTERNSHIP CYCLE

The internship goes from April 2011 - April 2012.

TUITION

The internship program has no tuition cost. You may have travel and lodging expenses if you live outside the Eugene area. Interns often work out arrangements to share these expenses.
